SUBJECT: Legislative Report

Listed below are the bills that the Board is following.

- SB 128, Emerson: An act to amend Section 921 of the Business and Professions Code, relating to healing arts – This bill will make a technical, nonsubstantive change to the Health Care Professional Disaster Response Act, which allows a physician and surgeon who meets specified criteria to obtain a license without paying fees.
Status: Introduced on January 22, 2013.
- AB 213, Logue: Healing Arts: Certification: Military Experience – Requires a healing arts board, on the presentation of evidence by an applicant for licensure or certification, to accept education, training, and practical experience completed in military service toward the qualifications and requirements of a license or certificate if it is equivalent to specified standards. Requires the Department of Veterans Affairs Chancellor of the California State University, and Chancellor of the California Community Colleges to provide technical assistance, as specified.
Status: Introduced on January 31, 2013.
